Shapes: Review circle, square, triangle, rectangle, oval, rhombus, box/cube, cone, ball/sphere, can/cylinder
Colors: Review all colors
*Skills that you are work on at home are: having your child write his/her name using correct form and holding the crayon or marker correctly, recognizing rhyming words, answering questions and speaking in complete sentences, and increasing vocabulary.
